One of our ongoing initiatives is for the Financial Well-being of members of all ages. National Financial Literacy Month is recognized each year in April to raise public awareness of the importance of financial literacy and maintaining smart money management habits. Our website has a page dedicated to Financial Literacy at https:// www.p1fcu.org/learn/financialliteracy. There, you will find topics with information to provide financial learning regarding many of the basic and advanced issues we all face in our financial lives. I encourage you to use these tools to help you make informed decisions on your financial situation and money choices to provide financial well-being.

We are offering a new product that will be a valuable benefit to our membership to help our youngest members build money management skills for a lifetime. Greenlight is a debit card for kids and much more. Kids can also use the app to track their spending, set savings goals, and learn key financial concepts.

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To participate, parents will simply enroll in Greenlight by visiting our Greenlight landing page (www.p1fcu.org/ greenlight), clicking on the "Sign Up" button to start creating an account, and linking their P1FCU account as funding source. Then, they can а start adding their children, setting up parental controls, and activating the Greenlight cards for their children.

This will allow parents to manage their children's finances and teach them valuable money management skills. After the initial account setup, they can access their Greenlight account through the Greenlight app as well. Some of the features are Parental Transfers to the child's account, parents can set up recurring allowances, incentivize completion by rewarding chore children with funds deposited to their account, and family members and friends can contribute funds to the child's Greenlight account.

Parent controls on spending allow parents to turn the debit card on and off and automatically block unsafe spending categories. Financial literacy is made fun for children with access to hands-on learning through videos, quizzes, and built-in lessons on how to earn, spend wisely, invest, and more. I want to thank our members for your continued loyalty and support of P1FCU through your membership. We are here to help you face your financial challenges in life.

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
